2009 AR-15 RIFLE CLINIC

Buffalo Creek Gun Club will be hosting AR-15 rifle clinics through the summer of 2009. These clinics have been designed to cover all aspects of High Power Rifle shooting. The clinics will each include an informative lecture on safety, handling, and function of the **AR-15** rifle. Each event will focus on one of the four positions used when shooting in competition according to the following schedule:

- **Sun. April 26, 2009: 200 yard SITTING RAPID FIRE**
- **Sun. May 31, 2009: 200 yard STANDING SLOFIRE**
- **Sat. June 13, 2009: 300 yard PRONE RAPID FIRE**
- **Sat. June,20, 2009: 600 yard PRONE SLOW FIRE**

Buffalo Creek Gun Club will furnish “National Match Grade” AR-15 rifles and ammunition for these clinics. Each shooter will be coached, one-on-one, by an NRA classified competitor. The price for these clinics is **\$55.00 ea. Or \$180.00 for the series of four (Pre-paid), ammunition included. (Juniors \$45 each/\$125 series**. If you wish to be instructed using your own service rifle, you will be allowed to do so. However, **BCGC** will only be able to furnish ammunition for those rifles using the .223 cartridges. Any other rifles will require you to furnish your own ammunition. Upon completion of these series, you will be fully prepared to confidently enter any **NRA** High Power Service Rifle Competition.

Competition of any of these clinics will satisfy the CMP requirements to purchase an **M1**.

Each clinic will conclude with a potluck lunch so bring a favorite picnic dish to share! The club will provide brats and soft drinks. In order to secure a shooting spot, Pre-registration is encouraged; call clinic coordinator at least one week prior to the date you wish to participate. Late entries will be accepted until 0715 on the day of the clinic, dependent on space availability. Range capacity is 44 shooters.
