Time: 8:00 A.M. Garand Springfield Military Rifle Clinic with 2 CMP certified GSM Master Instructors held prior to match. Match begins at 9:30 A.M. *Competitors must be at the range on or before 9:00 AM to participate!*

Location & Directions: US Hwy 285 South to Bailey. See map at www.bcgcc.com for directions from Bailey Propane Building on US 285, to range.

Competition open to: Open invitation. New shooters highly encouraged. All competitors must have a notarized “*Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement*” on file at the BCGC. Form available at www.odcmp.com/Competitions/Affidavit.pdf Notary may be available during match registration.

Allowable Firearms: Any “as issued” military service rifle that conforms to CMP rules 6.3 through 6.3.6 including but not limited to M-1 Garand, Springfield 1903/1903A3, U.S. Rifle Model 1917. M-1 Carbine, & As issued foreign military rifles. Unlimited and Special Military rifles that conform to CMP rules 6.4 and 6.4.1 will be allowed but will not be eligible for awards. CMP Rulebook is available at www.odcmp.com/Competitions/Rulebook.pdf . Limited number of loaner rifles available. Pre registration required.

Match Course: All competitors will shoot the same course of fire throughout the day which will be either John C. Garand Course A (5 sighters 30 record shots), or course B (5 sighters 50 record shots). Which course is fired, will be at the sole discretion of the Match Director. All firing will be from the 200 yard line with SR targets.

Rules: Per latest CMP Competitions Rule Book.

Ammunition: If ammunition is available from CMP, all competitors firing an M-1 Garand, 1903 Springfield, or a M-1917 must utilize supplied ammunition which will be available at cost. Foreign Rifle Competitors may utilize their personal ammunition provided it is deemed safe by Match Director and simply pay the Match Fee.

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze awards for top competitors per new 2010 cut scores. CMP purchase certificates will be available for all competitors.

Entry fee includes daily USFS/Camp Fickes range fee which allows use of short (100 yd) range for remainder of day.

The rifle marksmanship clinics are offered by CMP-affiliated organizations so individuals can fulfill the CMP marksmanship participation requirement to be eligible to purchase CMP rifles, to prepare clinic participants for target shooting events like Garand, Springfield Vintage Military Rifle and Rimfire Sporter Matches or to introduce new shooters to highpower service rifle competition. Even though they are called "Garand Clinics." These clinics provide firearm safety training and an introduction to target and range firing. The CMP also provides certificates of clinic completion to recognize clinic participants and verify marksmanship participation for government surplus rifle purchasers.
